APC3 TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF EMPLOYMENT

The terms and conditions for the post of Chief Executive were set by the Council in 1997 prior to becoming a Unitary Authority in April 1998.

The annual Chief Executive's pay award introduced a requirement for Councils to undertake a review of their conditions and also introduced a process of job appraisal specifically for this post.

As Halton had not undertaken a review nor introduced an appraisal system, the Director of the North Western Employers Organisation attended the meeting to provide independent advice.

RESOLVED: That

(1) the terms and conditions for the post of Chief Executive be amended as set out in the report of the Director of the North Western Employers Organisation;

(2) the Executive Director, Resources and Corporate Services be authorised to implement the terms and conditions with effect from 1st July 2002, subject to the agreement of the Chief Executive to the amended terms and conditions; and

(3) an appraisal scheme for the Chief Executive be introduced as detailed in Appendix B of the report of the Director of the North West Employers Organisation, and the said Director be approved to act as the Council's independent advisor for the purposes of the appraisal scheme.
