			Page 146 and the plans at P190,199 and 200 of the published printed agenda denotes a red line plan, an updated redline plan is shown below this table. Page 150 of the agenda states 38% of the homes proposed to be demolished are privately owned. This figure has been updated and is now 32%. Page 151 under Council services-Highways should read No objection subject to the use of conditions.  Page 154 of the agenda presents Table 1, the right hand column should read, 1 bed units 67 (21%), 2 bed units 95 (30%) and 3 bed units 155 (49%). Page 160 of the agenda makes reference to application 23/00178/FUL, this should read 23/00128/FUL. Page 165 of the agenda makes reference to 413 dwellings within

the redline boundary, this should read 462 dwellings. 
